- 1. Record your school winner reciting two memorized poems on VHS or DVD. Check to make sure the DVD will play on a DVD player.
- 2. Postmark by Friday morning, Feb. 8 and send to:

- 3. Be sure to have good lighting and sound on your recording. It is important to find someone who has a good camera which will give your student a clear picture and clear sound. Be careful of any background noises. If you don't have a microphone try to get the camera close to the student. It is more important to have good sound than be able to see the full student.
- 4. Have the student say his or her name at the beginning of the recording. DO NOT GIVE THE NAME OF THE SCHOOL. Give the title of the poem and the author and then recite the memorized poem. Wait a few beats before giving the title and author of the second poem and reciting it.
- 5. Complete the entry form below and enclose with your video.
