## **How about making a chart to show the new things your child is learning!**

Write your child's name at the top of a big piece of paper or tag board and include their picture. The refrigerator or their bedroom door is a great place to hang this.

With each new task learned, paste a picture of something they can cut out of a catalog or magazine that reflects the accomplishment. Example: If they've learned how to put their coat on by themselves, cut out a picture of a winter coat. If they've learned how to help pick up their toys, cut out a picture of a toy that they have and glue it on the paper.

Not only is your child learning how to do new things, they're also helping to create a "proud poster" to remind them of all of the new and exciting things they're learning to do.
