Your child may already experienced spending time in a daycare or preschool setting so they've spent time somewhere other than their home. As you're reading the book, talk with your child about the similarities that their teacher or daycare provider may have with their parent(s). How did they feel when they needed to follow rules somewhere other than home? Ask them if there's something at their school or daycare setting that they really like that you could have at home as well (a desk, a special place to hang their coat, a plate that has divisions). This may help with the transition or at least give them the opportunity to talk about any concerns they may have.
