Your child can develop a sense of time by becoming familiar with the patterns and sequences of events in his or her day. Use the paper plate clock to show the time that certain events occur during the day. For example, set the paper clock to the hour showing the time that your child begins the day. During snack time and playtime, have your child watch the real clock to see what time it is and set the paper plate clock to match that time. Try this activity for several days to help your child become familiar with his or her daily routines.

Learning to rhyme words is as easy as saying a word and seeing how many other words you and your child can think of that sound alike....rope, soap, hope, etc.. You're on your way to being a poet!
