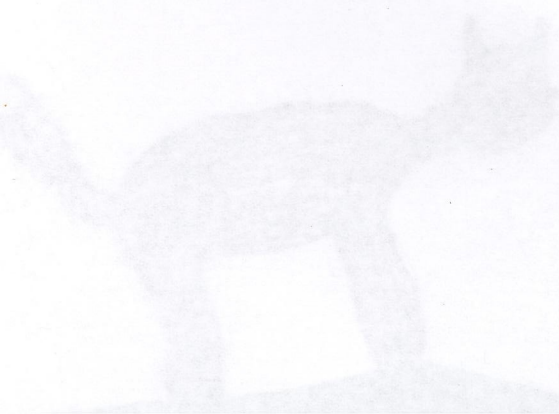


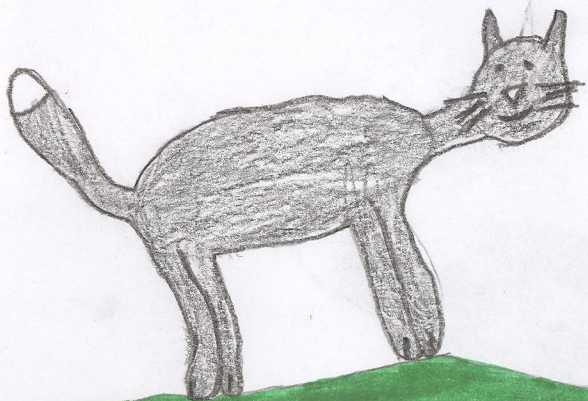
# Tippy and the Mouse

saw a mouse.






Tippy started playing with the
