

WHO IS THE BEAST?

Who is the beast? Take a walk through the jungle and you decide who the beast is.

This beautifully illustrated book gives your child the opportunity to find the different “beasts” or at least parts of them on each page (the paw, the tail, the nose). See if they can name some of the other jungle animals and how they are similar to the tiger (whiskers, strong legs). Each page has so many beautiful colors on it, see how many your child can identify.

Bring out the artist in your child by having them draw what they think the jungle looks like on a sheet of paper. Have them fill the paper up with lots of plants and flowers. Then on a separate sheet of paper, have them draw some of the animals that appear in the book and then cut them out. Cut a few slits on the piece of paper with the jungle scene so that you can slide your animals in and out of the slits to make them look like part of them is hiding or creeping through the bushes and flowers. Keep those creative juices flowing!
